There has been mention of, and minor legislative attempts, to create licensing of both radon testing and mitigation requirements. Therein lies my 2 questions and want for discussion/feedback.

Question #1: Should there be a separation between companies who offer radon testing and those that perform radon mitigation?

Question #2: Would you like WAHI to explore credentialing or licensing of radon testing and radon mitigation companies in Wisconsin?






