2. Better Google Rankings.

There's another huge benefit to online reviews, and that is that Google factors in your online reviews when ranking websites in their search results.

All else being equal, the businesses with more positive reviews tend to be more prominently displayed in Google's search results... which means more inspections booked for those inspectors.


